- Connecting emerging nonprofit leaders to more opportunities in the sector through our ListServ communication network of over 4,500 subscribers
- Awarding approximately \$2,000 each year in Chris Herron Professional Development grants to emerging nonprofit leaders to seek out opportunities they may not otherwise have access to
